

## Camping checklist

### Must wear class “A” uniform and show his rain gear to ride the bus

Ideally all gear would be packed in one duffle bag or one bag and the Sleeping bag.

Don't pack Rain gear or uniform in luggage

### Please label anything you want back.

#### Sleeping gear

- \_ Sleeping bag
- \_ Pillow
- \_ Pad or small cot (tent camping only)
- \_ Earplugs
- \_ Small flashlight
- \_ Sleepwear
- \_ Warm socks for cold weather

#### Clothing x days camping

- \_ Class “A” uniform
- \_ Pants (jeans, cargo, etc.)
- \_ T-shirts (appropriate art work only)
- \_ Sweatshirt or fleece
- \_ Socks
- \_ Underwear
- \_ Hat
- \_ Footwear Water proof hiking boots great but many guys wear tennis shoes
- \_ Swimsuit and towel

#### Personal care items

- \_ Toothbrush and paste
- \_ Comb/brush
- \_ Deodorant
- \_ Soap and shampoo
- \_ Contact stuff if needed
- \_ Bath towel
- \_ Water Bottle
- \_ Personal first-aid kit

#### What not to bring

- \_ Electronics of any kind
- \_ No weapon like toys
- \_ Bad attitude
- \_ Valuables (things get lost and broken)

#### Outdoors gear

- \_ Bug spray
- \_ Sunscreen
- \_ Rain gear (if you bring it we won't need it)
- \_ Coat
- \_ Gloves
- \_ Warm Hat
- \_ Hiking Boots

#### Extras

- \_ Spending money
- \_ Playing cards
- \_ Travel games
- \_ Pocketknife (must have toten chit first)
- \_ Sunglasses

#### Medications

In original container with clear written instructions send only enough for trip. Must be turned into medic before boarding bus. No exceptions.

The troop carries a supply of common OTC drugs that can be used if parent authorized it on the troop trip permission form.
